



We are thrilled to announce a cinematography masterclass with emerging Greek Director of Photography Akis Konstantakopoulos GSC, on June 2, 2024, at 2:30 PM at Regal LA Live. His recent film, LIGHT FALLS, directed by his mentor and LAGFF/GGFI Industry Leader Phedon Papamichael ASC CSG, will screen at the 18th LAGFF. And we are happy to partner with Los Angeles City College once again!

A graduate of Harvard University and the American Film Institute, Akis Konstantakopoulos has photographed over 25 features and 100 scripted/unscripted projects. Feature film credits include: ARISTOTLE AND DANTE DISCOVER THE SECRETS OF THE UNIVERSE for Aitch Alberto, with executive producer Lin-Manuel Miranda (world premiere TIFF '22); SHUT IN for blockbuster director D.J Caruso; LIGHT FALLS, a thriller directed by Oscar-nominated Phedon Papamichael, ASC (world premiere Camerimage '23); and RUNNING FOR GRACE, starring Jim Caviezel and Matt Dillon ("masterfully photographed by Akis" – Variety). More recently, Konstantakopoulos lensed Jon Erwin's latest film, JESUS REVOLUTION for Lionsgate, which was #2 at the box office in '23 for multiple weeks. In addition to his feature film work, he has photographed all 5 Seasons of the widely popular show THE CHOSEN (Prime, Peacock, Netflix, the CW) which has been the only TV show to be released theatrically, amassing over \$60 million at the box office. His commercial and music video clients include: Cher, The Lumineers, Paul Mitchell, Samsung, National Bank of Greece, FX, and HBO. Konstantakopoulos is a member of the honorary Greek Society of Cinematographers (GSC) and is represented worldwide by Zero Gravity Management.



Eugene Brancolini

Loyola Marymount University School of Film and Television Assistant Clinical Professor Eugene (Gino) Brancolini joined the faculty in 2007 and recently ended a six-year tenure as Graduate Director for its production MFA. Before joining the LMU faculty, Brancolini produced and directed public television documentaries and studio programming for WTIU, PBS Channel 30, Bloomington, Indiana, the public television station owned and operated by Indiana University. During his last decade at Indiana University, Brancolini worked as WTIU's Director of Production Services, managing a production unit that produced local, regional, and national public television programming. His work has been awarded both regional Emmys and CINE Golden Eagles. He has served as a documentary juror for various regional Emmys, the Broadcast Education Association, and the Kentucky Humanities Council. Brancolini holds a BS in Secondary Education, English, and an MS in Communication from Clarion State College (Pennsylvania). At LMU he teaches courses in documentary production, producing and directing shortform narrative fiction, directing fundamentals, and episodic television multi-camera studio production. Born and raised near Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Professor Brancolini holds both American and Italian citizenship. He and his wife Kristine reside in Redondo Beach, California.



Colin Campbell

Colin Campbell is a writer and director for theater and film. He was nominated for an Academy Award for his short film, "Seraglio," which also won Deauville's Grand Prix and ran on HBO. He directed the feature film Guido, starring Billy Zane, Armand Assante, Gary Busey, and Lupe Ontiveros. His productions of "The Ballad of Ricardo Flores Magon at the Ford Theater" and "Variedades on Olvera Street" were broadcast on KCET TV. His web series, "Dealbreakers," is on Amazon Prime. Colin has written and directed for Instant Films, winning Best Writer, Best Director, and numerous Best Film Awards. He has taught Theater and Filmmaking at Chapman University, Loyola Marymount University, Cal Poly Pomona University, Relativity Education, and to incarcerated youth through The Unusual Suspects. His solo show, Grief: A One Man ShitShow, premiered at the Hollywood Fringe Festival and ran for a month at New York's Theatre Row. The New York Times described it as "Unforgettable." Colin's book, Finding the Words: How to Work Through Profound Loss with Hope and Purpose, was published by Penguin Random House in 2023.



Maria Elena de las Carreras

Maria Elena de las Carreras is a Fulbright scholar and film critic from Argentina. She has a PhD in film studies and lectures on film history and esthetics at Cal State Northridge and UCLA. Carreras is the co-editor of Hollywood Goes Latin (2019). Since 2014, she has conducted research for the Visual History Program of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. She is a regular collaborator of the Latin American Cinemateca of Los Angeles and attends the Berlin Film Festival yearly as an accredited press. Carreras was a guest speaker in the Library of Congress inaugural Film and Sound Festival in 2023 and provided the audio commentary in the forthcoming release of the documentary Light Outs in Europe (1940). In May 2023 she conducted a Q&A with Mexican American documentary filmmaker Lourdes Portillo for the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences Museum. She also screened documentaries for the Sundance Film Festival and the Social Impact Media Awards and has been a documentary juror for the San Luis Obispo Film Festival and the SIMA Awards.




Cheng Guo

Cheng Guo is a Chinese professional working in visual development and concept art in China and the US. He has worked in the featured animation and video game industry since 2013. After successfully graduating from USC's School of Cinematic Arts, he joined the National Cartoonist Society, Animation Guild, and Asians in Animation. His clients include Warner Bros. Picture Animation, The Getty Center, Tencent, and other international companies. He has made a name for himself working on projects such as "DC League of Super-Pets," and Getty Unshuttered. His animation short "Kungfu Express" was selected by the International Film Festival of Wales, ANIMAZE Montreal International Animation Film Festival, and LA under the Stars Film Festival. He also works as an artist for the independent game ARIA, nominated for the IndieCade Game Festival.

Lisa Ogdie is a Short Film Programmer for the Sundance Film Festival. She has been part of the shorts programming team since 2009, selecting the Sundance short film slate from over 12,000 submissions each year, and has curated shorts for the 2019 and 2020 editions of the Durban Film Festival in South Africa. LAGFF INTERNSHIP PROGRAM 2024

LOYOLA MARYMOUNT UNIVERSITY

For its ninth year, the "Representations of Greece: Ancient and Modern" course offered new opportunities for LMU students to learn and engage with film and cultural theories. The course integrated study in the classroom with internships at the Los Angeles Greek Film Festival (LAGFF), which Prof. Katerina Zacharia, in her capacity as the LAGFF Director of Education, set up.

"Representations of Greece: Ancient and Modern" is a unique course that offers students the opportunity to study complex issues of representation through an interdisciplinary approach that highlights four areas of study: politics and economics; food and travel; theater and film; family, religion, and state. Students look at features attributed to 'the other' in the contact between cultures of asymmetrical power, explore how stereotypes are linked to contextual negotiations of identity, and consider how such identities may have originated in representations of Greece from antiquity to the modern era.


Students also gain first-hand experience with the inner workings of the LAGFF, working directly with the LAGFF Festival Manager, the Discovery Days team, and the Development, Publicity, and Production teams. Internship tasks include reviewing film submissions and projects in development, supporting social media, preparing film loglines for the LAGFF website, assisting with the sponsorship packets, and videography and hospitality during the festival days. The student-interns also produce blogs that include research essays inspired by the LAGFF film submissions, as well as internship reflections on performance, goals set and met, and skills honed and acquired.

LAGFF INTERNSHIP PROGRAM 2024

LOYOLA MARYMOUNT UNIVERSITY

Since the pilot LMU-LAGFF internship in 2014, over 200 LMU students have interned with LAGFF, and at least 120 more have attended the Greek cinema summer courses and written essays on the LAGFF films. The high response rate (80%) of a fall 2020 survey sent to our alumni, in combination with the overwhelmingly positive student responses, are spotlighted in an article on « Connecting the Liberal Arts, Classics and Film » published by the LMU Bellarmine College of Liberal Arts (3/4/21). The reason for the success of this course is that it provides a good background on Greek history, culture, and identity, integrating cultural and film theories to better equip the students for reviewing the Greek film submissions, hence the high quality of their reviews and research blogs. The Representations of Greece digital booklet includes over 60 student alumni testimonials and aims to publicize the course and the program and attract donors and new collaborations.

The LMU students and LAGFF team leaders signed a Handshake agreement through the LMU Career and Professional Development (CPD) office, which served as the guideline for the spring semester and secured some training for the summer. Rising senior, **Ariana Escobar** ('25, Film & TV Production), recent graduate, **Cleofe Finkle** ('24 Screenwriting, minor in History), and two graduate Film Production students, **Thomas Klapp** ('26, MFA), and **Ryan Hrabak** ('24, MFA), are interning at the festival this summer.

In her capacity as the 2023 LMU Center of Teaching Excellence Faculty Fellow for the Office for International Students and Scholars, Prof. Zacharia instituted and curated the five-day LMU Greek Cinema: Homage to Dionysus, to celebrate 24 years of Greek Cinema at LMU at SFTV Broccoli Theater on March 5-12, 2024. The 16 selected fiction features, documentaries, and short films tell stories that reckon with human nature's irrational currents hidden within the self, and the state, and offer a framework for renegotiating dominant structures in society. Together, they offer an homage to the most epiphanic Olympian god, Dionysus. The ancient god draws men and women out of their static sense of self (ec-stasy),

rendering them strangers to their social self, to help them discover that life and death entwine and intersect, and the Same is necessarily inhabited by the Other. This event was a cross-school collaboration between the departments of Classics & Archaeology, and Film, Television & Media Studies. It was sponsored by three Colleges, namely, the Bellarmine Forum, the School of Film & Television, the College of Communication and Fine Arts, as well as by the Office of Global Local Affairs in the Provost's Office, and the Office of International Students and Scholars in Student Affairs.



Katerina Zacharia is a Professor of Classics at Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles. Her publications include Converging Truths: Euripides' Ion and the Athenian Quest for Self-Definition (2003), Hellenisms: Culture, Identity and Ethnicity from Antiquity to Modernity (2008), and articles on classical antiquity in visual culture, Greek tourism, and cultural politics. She wrote, directed, and produced the

award-winning short documentary Blessings and Vows (2018), which has screened at 34 film festivals and garnered nine international awards. She published "Into the Light: Making Blessings and Vows" (Ergon 2021). Prof. Zacharia co-created Enthralled, a new conversation game for higher education, drawing on classical drama. Her work has been supported with fellowships from the A.S. Onassis Foundation, A.G. Leventis Foundation, Heritage Management Organization, Stanford University, and innovative teaching awards, including the 2023 Society of Classical Studies Excellence in Teaching at the University level; 2019 LAX Chamber of Commerce Eddy Award; 2018 LMU President's Fritz B. Burns Distinguished Teaching Award. Prof. Zacharia is an experienced dramaturge and serves as Artistic Associate for the Cacoyannis Foundation in Athens. She was a LAGFF juror (2014) and programmer (2015-18). As the Director of Education for the Los Angeles Greek Film Festival, she has created a vibrant student internship program with Loyola Marymount University since 2014.
